



## HOW TO USE FUEL STICK

The Fuel Stick System allows accurate dosing of the tank without having to do any complex math equations or worry about having to fill the fuel tank completely with each fill. It also works with a simple top up. No messy liquids or loose bottles to worry about either.



Open your fuel filler cap. Roughly determine how many litres of fuel you will be placing in the fuel tank during your fill up.



For this example, we will be putting about 60 litres of fuel into our fuel tank. Each tablet in the 300 litre and 600 litre packs treats 20 litres of fuel. So for 20 litres, you would use one tablet, for 40 litres, you would use two tablets, etc. Fuel Stick is very easy to measure and use.



So, if you are going to put in 60 litres of fuel, you will need to snap off three tablets of Fuel Stick. Simply snap off the appropriate number of tablets you need each time you fuel up. If you are only doing a top up, treat only the new fuel. If you are adding an odd number of litres such as 10 litres, use one tablet, or for 50 litres of fuel, use three tablets. It is important not to under dose the fuel.



Place the Fuel Stick tablets into the fuel tank as far as possible. If your fuel filler has a screen like ours does in the photo, simply place the Fuel Sticks in the filler and push them through with the fuel nozzle.



Insert the Fuel Nozzle and deliver the required amount of fuel. When finished, simply return the Fuel Nozzle back to the pump and replace your filler cap. That's it, we're done.

It is important to ensure that you do not under treat the fuel. It is better to add an additional tablet to make sure the fuel is properly dosed than to put in less than the amount of fuel. For example, if you are putting in 50 litres, use three tablets instead of two. By using only two tablets, the fuel is under treated, and you will not receive the full benefit of the product. It is not possible to over treat the fuel...the product will perform the same with the correct amount as it will with double or more of the correct amount. Adding more than the required amount of Fuel Stick will not harm any part of your engine, or hamper performance. However, you will not see additional benefit from overuse of the product.
